In previous years, we have held the event in April but last year was such a great success with beautiful weather that we are hosting in May again. We are so appreciative of all your support throughout the years and feel so grateful for all you've invested in the lives of these children.

The collection will be May 23-24 from 9am-5pm in the main parking area at Johnston Community College. JCC has always been supportive of this ministry. They provide the trailer for us to load the items into and then deliver them for us to Kennedy Home in Kinston. There is a list of needed items enclosed along with a promotional flyer for you to distribute to your congregation. Please bring your non-perishable items in smaller sized boxes (easier to lift and load). They also can use gift cards to help with the purchase of fresh foods (meats, milk, butter, fruits and vegetables) as well as foods for those children with special dietary needs (diabetes, peanut allergies, etc.).

Thank you so much for your support for NC Baptist Children's Home and the precious boys and girls they minister to. Also, please continue to remember their new ministry with Foster Care & Foster to Adopt. At TEBA, we are working with several families to begin the process of licensing with the state to serve as foster families. If you are interested in this, call the Association office for more information. They are working with staff from Kinston and will begin the training classes soon.
