

# YOUTH MINISTRY INTERN

First Baptist Church of Clayton, NC is seeking a paid Youth Ministry Intern. The position is to serve as a learning opportunity through relational ministry to middle and high school students. The other role will be to coordinate summer activities with the assistance of the Youth Council. The intern will be accountable to the Youth Council.

## INTERNSHIP DESCRIPTION

The overall objective is to present and show by example the gospel of Jesus Christ to young people and to encourage them in their growth through the study of scripture, prayer, service, and fellowship. Specific activities may include:

- Plan and carry out activities with youth as assigned by the Youth Council.
- Develop relationships with youth, parents, and volunteer staff through a variety of individual and group communication methods and activities.
- Assist the Youth Ministry volunteers in planning and executing ministry programs. These include Bible studies, small groups, special events, retreats, and mission projects.
- Maintain personal, spiritual and professional growth.

## REQUIRED SKILLS

- Growing personal commitment to Jesus Christ, the body of Christ, and God's work in the world.
- Ability to work effectively with youth, exhibiting enthusiasm, creativity, understanding and patience.
- Excellent organizational, communication and leadership skills.
- Ability to verbally articulate personal faith and a biblical worldview.
- While the preferred applicant is a student in seminary/divinity school, undergraduate students are also encouraged to apply.

## TIME COMMITMENT

Part-time (10-15 hours per week) with flexible days and some ability to work remotely.

## EVALUATIONS

The Youth Council will provide assessment of performance during the internship and the end of the assignment. Additional assessments will be provided in accordance with the intern's academic institution requirements if the intern is receiving school credit.
